

Code of ethics for tutors/mentors

- 1. I understand that my role is to encourage and enable young people to achieve their unique potential as independent learners through acknowledgement, encouragement, understanding, and personalised attention.
- 2. I will be careful to avoid creating any unhealthy dependencies by suggesting a need for tutoring where no such need exists; reporting in a manner that explicitly or implicitly suggests a need for further on-going tutoring or engaging in any practice that undermines the independent learning of pupils.
- 3. I will not engage in any form of plagiarism, such as completing a young person's work' or homework assignments for them.
- 4. I will demonstrate faith in the young people I work with in relation to their learning ability and provide honest, positive and constructive feedback.
- 5. I understand the need to be flexible in my approach to assist young people in discovering effective learning strategies.
- 6. I undertake to keep up-to-date with advances in subject knowledge and pedagogy.
- 7. I undertake to comply with Pendynas Ltd, Child Protection Policy.
- 8. I am committed to identifying any particular challenges or difficulties young people might have with their learning and to assist them in overcoming those barriers.
- 9. I will share with Pendynas Ltd any concerns I have about a young persons' social, emotional and behavioural difficulties that are beyond my competency to address.
- 10. I will identify to Pendynas Ltd any special educational needs that are beyond my experience or ability to resolve, in order that they may secure the right kind of specialist help.
- 11. I understand that my relationship to the young people with whom I work is professional and not personal and that I have a duty of care towards them.
- 12. I will keep information about the young people whom I am assigned confidential, unless doing so would be to result in injury or harm being done to them.
- 13. I will show respect for the young people I engage with in respect of their cultural background, personal dignity and values.
- 14. I will maintain accurate records of sessions as expected and required and forward daily reporting forms to Pendynas Ltd.
- 15. I will respect the values and ethos of Pendynas Ltd, and in particular, will not seek to damage their business interests through my actions.
